* The Te Rito-sponsored award aims to get our rangatahi envisioning what their world looks like when their families/whānau are safe and supportive. We want to encourage youth to be the flag-bearers for non-violence in their own relationships, too, and be a significant part of ending the cycle of violence by growing a positive mindset towards the ones we love.

- Te Rito will judge submissions from a static medium (paint, sculpture, photography etc)
- There will be two categories for prizes – “primary school” and “secondary school/tertiary setting” awards
- First prize in each category is \$300 for the winning schools/tertiary setting
- Runner Up in each category will receive \$200 for the school/tertiary setting
- The winners will be the submissions that represent the theme **“Healthy Relationships Promoting a Healthy Environment”**
- Winners will be chosen by Te Rito collaboration judges and their decisions will be final
- Winners will be announced on the day of the FLAVA festival.
